

**Testing Requested:** Overall migration in accordance with the requirements of the Plastic Materials and Articles in Contact with Food Commission Regulation (EU) No. 10/2011 following Methods BSEN 1186-1:2002, BSEN 1186-3:2002 and BSEN 1186-14:2002.

**Test Requirement:** The Regulations require that no plastic material shall be capable of transferring its constituents to food with which it may come into contact in quantities exceeding the appropriate limit. For the material the appropriate limit is 10 mg/dm<sup>2</sup>.

Results: Please refer to the Appendix

**Conclusion:** The migration from the material was less than the maximum permitted by the Regulations.
